



Association of Dental Support Organizations Applauds Wisconsin Governor Tony Evers for Signing into Law Measures to Enhance Dental Care Affordability and Accessibility for Wisconsin Residents

Washington, D.C. (January 31, 2024) – In response to Wisconsin Governor Tony Evers signing into law [AB62/SB63](#), a bill related to assignment of insurance benefits, and [AB666/SB692](#), a bill related to dentist and dental hygienist licensure, the [Association of Dental Support Organizations](#) (ADSO) Chief Executive Officer Andrew Smith today released the following statement:
